

Declarations for 100 days

Thank you for joining us in making biblical, faith-filled declarations over our lives, families, churches, cities and nations for 100 days from 15 September to 24 December.

In Haggai 2:19, God promised to bless the nation of Israel as it turned back to Him and began to rebuild the temple in Jerusalem. He said, “From this day on I will bless you” and that day was 24 Kislev on the Hebrew calendar. This year that date falls on Christmas day on the Gregorian calendar, which also happens to coincide with the Jewish festival Hanukkah.

We believe this is not a coincidence and that the same promise is available for us as God’s people who believe and follow Jesus Christ. We are therefore going to declare God’s word over our lives and situations in preparation for this time. Please feel free to use the confessions below and add to them what is relevant to you and your circumstances. You might want to include declarations for your nation especially in the run up to elections.

We believe that the world came into being as God spoke it into existence and we too can decree a thing and it be established. Proverbs 18:21 clearly states that “Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits.” So say your declarations out loud on a daily basis and believe that God’s word is true and will come to pass in your life as you confess them by faith this year.

- I walk in the good and favourable plans of the Lord this year (Jeremiah 29:11)
- I lack no good thing in Christ and have an abundant supply (Philippians 4:19)
- I dwell and abide in the secret place of God’s presence (Psalm 91:1)
- I walk in the power and anointing of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:25)
- I remain in prayer and praise and the word of God (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
- I fear no evil but trust in God and walk in His peace (Psalm 23:4)
- I pray for my family and know that He will take care of them (Isaiah 54:13)
- I support, encourage and meet with the body of Christ (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- I pray for and share the gospel with unbelievers (Matthew 28:19-20)
- I pray for the peace and protection of my city and nation (Jeremiah 29:7)
- I pray for the peace, protection and salvation of Israel (Psalm 122:6)
